











Construction Worker BUMP!



Sensory Play Ideas

- •Farm sensory bin Fill a container with a base of dried corn and add toy farm animals, raffia, wooden cups and bowls, garden tools for digging, toy tractor, toy fences, etc.
- •Firefighter sensory bin Fill a container with a base (such as popcorn kernels or dried black beans) and add toy firefighters, toy fire trucks, red/yellow/orange shredded paper and/or pom poms, etc.
- •Construction sensory bin Fill a container with a base of rocks and sand. Add toy construction vehicles, larger rocks, nuts and bolts toy street signs, etc.
- •Add emergency vehicles to the sand or water table.
- •Use vehicle cooke cutters (fire truck, etc.) with play dough.
- •Add toy com nunity helper figurines and/or toy vehicles to the block center.
- •Build with play dough and cheft sticks for defisy activity mene.
- •Sand and spray Put sand in a Sin. Chief en can spray with a water bottle and then make prints of their hand, the bottom of a toy, etc. They can pretend to be police officers examining clues.
- •Playdough candy Give children clean plastic candy trays (from trays of chocolates) and brown play dough. Have then mole the play dough into candi to fill it the tray.
