How to Play

"What's My Category?"

1. Deal seven cards to each player. Players place their cards face up and put the remaining cards face down in the center of play.
2. The first player turns over a card from the deck and looks for a card in his hand that matches the pattern. He lays the card down and says "Guess my category." Players take turns choosing a card from their row that matches the category. They may pass if they do not have a card that matches.
3. Play continues until every player has played all the cards that fit the category. The last player to play names the category and keeps all the cards that were played. (If the player incorrectly names the category, the player to his left may have a chance to guess the category and keep the cards.)
4. At the end of the round, players choose enough cards to get them back up to seven cards. The player to the left of the first player chooses the next card and begins the next round.
5. When the deck is empty, the player with the most cards wins.
